A. Examination Schedule for Grades III to XII

(i) Periodic Tests (25 Marks to be conducted)

(two chapters to be included in Periodic test)

Half Yearly Examination	September 2026 (with 80% syllabus for Grade IX and XI)

Periodic Test 4	28th Jan - 5th Feb 2027 /last week of January (Grade III TO VIII)
* No Periodic Test- 4 for grade IX and XI .	

B. Examination Schedule for Grades X to XII

C. Assessment Criteria for Foundation Classes (Pre-KG to Grade II)

(i) No formal examinations.

(ii) Formative Assessment I: Mid-September

(ii) Formative Assessment II: March

(i) Bag-less policy for Foundation Classes.

(ii) Students' notebooks will be shown during the PTM (Parent-Teacher Meetings).

(iii) Reading books will be sent home regularly.

(iv) Practice notebooks to be kept at home.

D. Internal Assessment Criteria (20 Marks)

(Applicable for Term–I Half Yearly Examination & Term–II Final Examination)

The Internal Assessment of 20 marks will be awarded as per the following components:

1. Average of Two Periodic Tests – 10 Marks

The average of the best two Periodic Tests conducted during the term will be calculated.

The marks obtained will be converted into 10 marks.

2. Notebook Work – 5 Marks

Assessment will be based on:

Regularity and timely completion of classwork & homework

Neatness and presentation

Proper maintenance and correction of notebooks

3. Subject Enrichment Activity – 5 Marks

This includes:

Practical work / Lab activities (for relevant subjects)

Projects / Assignments / Viva

Speaking & Listening activities (for languages)

Any subject-specific competency-based task

Note: All students must appear in the periodic tests and complete the required notebook work and subject enrichment activities.

Internal Assessment marks once awarded will be final and will be reflected in the Report Card.

E. Annual Theory Exam Syllabus Distribution (for Grade III TO IX and XI)

Grades III – V: 20% of Term 1 + Entire Term 2

Grade VI: 40% of Term 1 + Entire Term 2

Grade VII: 60% of Term 1 + Entire Term 2

Grade VIII: 80% of Term 1 + Entire Term 2

Grades IX to XII: As per CBSE guidelines

G. Important Notes for Parents:

- (i) A minimum of 33 % is required to pass the Final Examination (Grades III to VIII).
- (ii) The Annual Examination schedule will align with the CBSE Board Exam date sheet.
- (iii) A tentative date sheet will be shared in advance. The final date sheet will be provided one week before exams.
- (iv) Re-examination for absentees/slow learners (Grades III to XII) will be conducted on payment of Rs. 500 per subject (except for students on school duty).
- (v) Discipline Grading (3-Point Scale) (Grades III to VIII) will consider Attendance Sincerity& Uniform Compliance Behavior, Values, Tidiness Respect for Rules& Regulations, Attitude towards Society, Nation, and School.
- (vi) Students receiving below a "C" grade in discipline will be moved to a different section for better performance.
- (vii) The school does not guarantee section allotment at the time of promotion.
- (viii) Answer scripts will be shown to parents after the Half-Yearly Examinations during PTM (for Grades (III to VIII).
- (ix) Answer scripts will be shown to parents for Grades IX to XII. Any discrepancies in marks must be addressed at the time of the follow-up. Marks will not be changed once the answer scripts have been handed over to parents.
- (x) Admit cards for Grades X and XII will not be issued to students with a shortage of attendance or those absent from Periodic Tests and Half-Yearly Exams. Such students will also not be allowed to participate in school excursions and celebrations.
- (xi) All Periodic Tests are compulsory.
- (xii) The entrance exam will be conducted from Grade I onwards. Any child who is six years of age or above must sit for the entrance exam.
- (xiii) In Grade VI-VIII, following Skilled Based (Vocational) Subjects will be introduced in the academic session 2026-27
